## Senior Clearance and School Magazine

Clearance time is almost here. Senior clearance will be held on Tuesday 25 and Wednesday 26 October. For your son/daughter to be eligible to receive a 2016 school magazine, all subject and sports costs and the school donation must have been paid in full, unless an automatic payment is operating and all costs are paid in full by the end of Term 4. ### Student to leave school during the day

- Please provide a note for your student to take to their Head of House
- Student is to obtain an 'Exit Permit' from their Head of House **before Tutor time**

### If a student is unwell during the course of the day

- They should go to the nurse.

### If a student is late to school before tutor time finishes

- The student must go to their Tutor Teacher to sign in late

### If the student is late to school after tutor time

- The student **must sign in at the Student Office and**
- **Provide a note** from the parent/caregiver advising the reason for being late
