Senior Clearance and School Magazine

Clearance time is almost here. Senior clearance will be held on Tuesday 25 and Wednesday 26 October. 

- Student is to obtain an 'Exit Permit' from their Head of House before Tutor time


If a student is unwell during the course of the day

SpeedMeet will provide a speed interview situation. Students will meet with employers looking for new employees for around 5 minutes each.


Employers will be from a range of industries that offer on-the-job training and exciting career opportunities
