Senior exams finished yesterday, and students should reflect on their preparation for the exams and how they felt about their performance in the exam room. It is important that our senior students make good use of the feedback they will get from the marking of these exams, and do their best to improve their revision process ahead of the external exams in November.



[StudyIt](#) forums for NCEA English, Maths and Science will reopen on 21 September to support Year 11-13 students preparing for end of year external exams. The online learning platform provides moderated forums to discuss achievement standards and general study and exam advice for NCEA English, Maths and Science from other students and facilitators.

Senior students have been advised that applications for school-awarded scholarships are now open and application forms are available at the Student Office.
