

From the Principal *Tena koutou katoa*

Progress reports are being issued this afternoon. They indicate progress against a rubric of learning habits, which is on the reverse of the report. Please read this carefully with your son or daughter and discuss with them how they can achieve the goals they have set for themselves this year.

In assemblies this week, I have emphasised that vaping is not to occur at school or on the way to or from school. **The Smokefree Environments and Regulated Products Act 1990** was amended last year to include vaping:

Section 7A states "Smoking and vaping prohibited at schools and early childhood education and care centres" and "The managers of school premises or premises to which subsection (4) applies must take all reasonably practicable steps to ensure that—
no person smokes or vapes in any part of the premises (whether an internal area or an open area) at any time on any day;"

This legislation came into force on 11 November 2020.

Students are not to bring vapes or vaping materials to school. Such items will be confiscated and will be returned only to the parents or caregivers.

The competition is live on their [website](#) and two winners will each receive 3x AA driving school lessons.





Bike Cage


