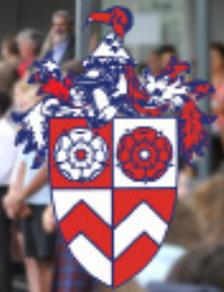


Rosehill College News

Term 4 Week 1 Senior Practice Exams & Tuesday 26 October Workshop Day

1. Dates - Wednesday 20 October, Thursday 21 October, Friday 22 October, Tuesday 26 October Workshop Day.

In the Hall, S Block and C Block. Workshops in normal subject rooms.

2. Times - 9am - 12pm and 1 - 4pm each of the three days. Leaving the grounds when the exam/workshop is finished.

3. Subject Exams/Workshops - The Period 2 and Period 4 timetabled subjects of each day. Can be a 2-3 hour exam or a 3 hour workshop.

4. Exam Leave - if students have external standards then they turn up for the exam/workshop. If not they stay home.

5. Schedule & Instructions is on Studenthub and has been shared with all Year 11, 12, 13 students.

6. Unable to attend - advise the School in the morning.

7. Health & Safety - Best to wear a mask. Sanitise hands. Will be seated in rows, facing front and separated, in ventilated rooms.

8. Tuesday 26 October Workshops: 9am - 12pm and 12.30 - 3.30pm are only those subjects listed on the Schedule and only for Seniors who have practical-based externals.
